TAKE NOTHING WITH YOU He called the twelve and began to <u>send them out</u> two by two, and authority them over the gave unclean spirits. <u>He ordered them to</u> nothing for their journey take except a staff; no bread, no bag, no money in their belts; but to wear and not to put sandals on two tunics. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave the place. If any place will not welcome you and they refuse to hear you, as you leave, shake off the dust that is on your feet as a testimony against them." So they went out and proclaimed that all should repent. They cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

This week's Gospel reminds us of what Jesus expects from us still today. Just like it was up to the first disciples to share the Good News back then, it is now up to us.
