CHRIST THE KING

JOHN 18:33-37: YES, I AM A KING

‘Are you the king of the Jews?’ Pilate asked... Jesus replied, ‘Mine is not a kingdom of this world; if my kingdom were of this world, my men would have fought to prevent my being surrendered to the Jews. But my kingdom is not of this kind.’ ‘So you are a king then?’ said Pilate. ‘It is you who say it’ answered Jesus. ‘Yes, I am a king. I was born for this, I came into the world for this: to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to my voice.’

This year, Pope Francis has declared that the worldwide Church will celebrate World Youth Day every year, on the Sunday before Advent. This is also the Feast of Christ the King!

This is a reminder that Jesus is King, and that as daughters and sons of God - we are born royalty too! Jesus was a servant king, the best example to us of how to love one another.
