"THEY WERE ALL FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT"

When Pentecost day came round, they had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them. Jesus may have returned to Heaven, but we have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit, to inspire and guide us while we remain on Earth.
